Join our community-based oil buying syndicate

Helping you in your own community is your local volunteer coordinator:

They can help explain the scheme, take orders, provide local advice and guidance, especially important if you are new to oil.

What's the scheme about?

Community First Oxfordshire runs an oil buying scheme—OxOil—that helps to reduce the cost of your domestic heating oil each time you place an order. We aim to achieve the lowest possible prices for heating oil.

What's the snag?

There isn't one. By bringing communities throughout Oxfordshire together to make the most of joint buying power, we can make savings for our members. All members pay the same price irrespective of amount of oil ordered.

The environment benefits too

With one tanker delivering to several customers in a community, the carbon footprint is reduced along with traffic in the village and surrounds and its more economic for the supplier.

Professional Oil Negotiators

We use a specialist buying team at AF Affinity to negotiate and place our orders. In 2015 they purchased over 7.1 million litres of heating oil. They are a subsidiary of Anglia Farmers, a mutual company formed under the Co–Operative & Community Benefit Society. No more phoning around numerous suppliers for the best price, we do that all for you.

Local Volunteer Coordinators

In line with our Charities philosophy of helping communities help themselves, where possible we operate through local volunteer coordinators. They provide us with a local presence in your community and:

- will remind you when an oil order is due
- help resolve any issues
- provide extra support for those who need it from reading oil gauges, to
 helping those with no internet/computer facilities or knowledge.

5 easy steps to cheaper heating oil

Step 1: Join the Scheme

Step 2: Membership Details confirmed

We will confirm your membership details and let you know if you have a local volunteer co-ordinator in your area. If so, your details will be forwarded on to them, if not, Community First Oxfordshire will act as your co-ordinator. You will receive details of our ordering and delivery dates and Direct Debit form to pay for the oil

Step 3: Place an order

You will be reminded when an oil order is due and either place your order with your local co-ordinator or direct with our oil negotiators AF Affinity. Your order increases our negotiating power, so once submitted we regard it as binding.

Step 4: Sit back whilst we negotiate the price

AF Affinity will negotiate the best price from a whole range of suppliers. We will advise you who the supplier is, the price per litre (exclusive of VAT) and the approximate date of delivery.

Step 5: Take delivery of the oil and pay.

The oil will be delivered and an invoice will be sent to you by email. If a Direct Debit is in place, AF Affinity will take payment for the oil the month following delivery.

Annual membership fee

There is an annual membership fee of £24.00 (£20.00 plus VAT) for individual households, companies or community buildings. Payable by cheque or BACS only
