- 6. To consider any Planning Matters. Amended plan received for extension to "Old Walls", Buckland Road. Amended plans and application had been These had been circulated and it was agreed that, since there was no vital difference to the original application, the Clerk reply stating that the Parish Council's previous observations still stood.
- To consider letter from District Valuer regarding Playing Field Lease. Chairman read the letter out. A fter some discussion it was agreed that the Clerk reply to the District Valuer requesting that a Lease be drawn up and presented to the Parish Council for approval. At this time the Parish Council would then consider seeking further advice from the Oxfordshire Association of Local Councils. Ody suggested that the fence between the Playing Field and the Paddock to the north It was agreed that this be done, since it seemed unlikely that it would be required to replace it at the end of the term. Mr. V. Hodgkins thought that the fence on the south should repaired.

There followed a general discussion regarding the further possibility of purchasing the land at below market value. Mr. J. Ody had had a meeting with the Executive Committee of Oxfordshire Playing Field Association at which Mr. Sinclair had quoted some Councils that had obtained land on these terms. Mr.Ody.produced a letter from the Youth Club asking for a meeting to consider "educational aspects" as referred to by the Charity Commission. Mrs. T. Cox suggested holding a Referendum. Mr. Ody and Mr. Rumble thought this would be inadvisable at this time. Mr. V. Hodgkins said that at the Annual Assembly Meeting it had been agreed that as soon as there , was something positive regarding purchase to be discussed a General Village Meeting would be called. It was therefore agreed to leave this matter until the next meeting by which time it might be possible to fix a date for a general meeting Mr. J. Ody proposed a vote of thanks to Mr. Clarke sometime in the Autumn. for taking out the shrubby trees at the entrance to the playing field.

- Matters arising from Annual Assembly.
 - This was not considered to be necessary, but it was agreed to Street Naming. bring the matter up at the next meeting.
 - Street Cleaning. Mr. J. Ody reported that Mrs. Venn received £2. 50 per hour for three hours a week and she was satisfied with this. However, it was agreed that she should also be paid during ' her holiday, which would be taken at her convenience.
 - Garage by Ock Green. Mr. J. Ody said he would approach the Landlord to put some pressure to bear upon the occupier. Mr. Hodgkins said he had tried the "softly" approach with little effect.
- Mr. E. Clarke had received To report letter from Mr. P. Morgan, Chapel Lane. a letter from Mr. P. Morgan complaining about noise and nuisance from the Youth Club members using the Villa ge Hall on Friday evenings. Mr. Clarke said he had an amicable meeting with Mr. Morgan and Mr. Ody said things had improved recently.
- Mr. V. Hodgkins said that since the letter was not addressed to the Parish Council he felt that there was no call for a reply. This was agreed. Mr. G. Rumble commente d that although the Y outh Club was a valuable function it should not grow too large for the Hall and that the Leader should ensure this. Mr. J.
