



### CONSULTATION ON THE LOCAL PLAN 2031 – PART 2

The Local Plan 2031 Part 2 sets out policies and locations for housing for the Vale of White Horse district's proportion of Oxford's housing need up to 2031, which cannot be met within the City boundaries. The document also contains policies for part of the Didcot Garden Town.

## ARCHAEOLOGICAL DIG – FOLLOW UP MEETING

The various finds, from the four archaeological test pits (see last issue), were all bagged up, labelled and stored. The dig took place over the weekend of 16th/17th September with two test pits on The Green and two in the grounds of Mill Cottage. The finds included pottery, metal items and slag, buttons, coins, pottery, a bottle, glass and ceramic ball bottle stoppers, animal bones, a musket ball, a Bellarmine pottery jug shard, a copper alloy ring, and a Mesolithic worked flint.



The next stage is to clean and dry all of these finds so that they can be properly identified and recorded in the layer they came from.

This will be carried out in the **Village Hall on Wednesday 15th November, 7pm-9pm.**
