Mr. Eld asked whether anything could be done about increasing parking at The Chequers P.H. The Chairman said that this would be looked into

There was some protracted discussion regarding erecting street name signs and it was agreed that Chapel Lane would be adopted not Bi Butts Lane New Road not School Road The decision for Main Street or High Street 9 for , 9 against Mr V. Hodgkins suggested that the householders be approached for a final decision This was Agreed Mr. C. Eld then reported on his progress as Emergency Officer and said he had attended a number of seminars. He had prepared a questionnaire copies of which he passed around This was a draft only and a further one would be sent to every household for completion after any amendments had been made
