

St Peter's Church

St Peter's Church is a Grade 1 listed building of special historic interest. Some sections date from the early 12th century, though a worshipping community was probably present in the village from several hundred years earlier. There is a very unusual tympanum of Normano-Celtic design inside, and a set of 12th century Romanesque foliate heads frames the south door. An interesting history booklet is available in the church.

The church is normally open during the day and at service times which vary throughout the month. Details are on the noticeboard in the church porch. For access at other times, please contact the churchwarden.
