For those interested in the application made by the Society of Friends for a Premises Licence, the full application is now available under 'Latest News' on the village website at [Welcome - The Village of Charney Bassett](#). The application includes a plan showing the buildings and those parts of the grounds to which the application refers.

The application is in several parts, and can be summarised as:

- A licence to supply alcohol for consumption (inside and outside) on and off the premises:
 - o For guests and residents at any time;
 - o For those attending events (limited to 20 per annum) from mid-day to 00.30 hours;
- A licence to play amplified recorded music indoors at events from 23.00 - 01.00 hours;
- A licence to play amplifies live music indoors at events from 23.00 – 00.30 hours.

Anyone making representations (for or against) should have regard to guidance provided by the Government at [Guidance for Interested Parties: Making Representations August 2009 \(whitehorsesdc.gov.uk\)](#) and the District Council's own Premises Licence policy at [Joint-Statement-of-Licensing-Policy-2021-2026.pdf \(whitehorsesdc.gov.uk\)](#).

Several residents have already expressed concerns and the Parish Council is now considering making comment. To help with this and to allow for an exchange of information and ideas, a meeting has been arranged for **Wednesday 24th March at 6.30 pm**. This will obviously have to be a virtual meeting and anyone wishing to attend can do so by using the skype link <https://join.skype.com/dMJ2zpOjkCqG>.

The Parish Council uses skype as it is a free platform where meetings are not time-limited. You should be able to attend whether or not you have the skype application loaded to your computer or phone. But for Apple users you may experience difficulty with the video link if you do not already have the app. uploaded.

Although it is not essential, it would be helpful if you could let the Parish Clerk (Trevor Brown - parishclerk@charneybassett.org.uk) know in advance if you might attend. It might also be useful if you could provide a telephone number to help sort out any connection problems on the night.
