

Field Safety Report from Bruce Royan 31.7.23

- Clearly, we have had some vandalism related to the pigeon spikes and fencing. Thanks to help from Brian and David the fence is fixed. As noted above I will repair the spikes as soon as I can get up a ladder again safely. There is much speculation about who did it however as we have no constant surveillance it will be difficult to know for sure and with the park being so open difficult to prevent repeat incidents if those involved decide to come back again. If it happens again I will call 111 just to register it with the police
- Also, it appears that somebody or somebodies are removing the tent poles from the back of the goal nets. I have replaced some however if they keep on disappearing we may just have to leave the nets loose. The rabbit damage is becoming more widespread again on the nets
- I believe David has spoken with Steven Burge about helping repair the southern goal post corner frame
- There have been a few additional rabbit holes as it is summer but this is not as bad as in the past
- For the moment there is sufficient bark in the play areas of the park. Rebarking is however something we may want to consider for summer 2024 depending on outcome of annual inspection in Jan
